Forum pieces can be personal or explanatory essays, commentary on news events, reflections on cultural trends and more, so long as there is a clear viewpoint and understanding of the topic. Writers can approach their topic from any position, but it must bear on the specifics of the topic with regard to policy with rigorous detail and defense. We are interested in anything well-written with a fact-based viewpoint we believe will contribute to the political discourse of Pitt.

Forum pieces can be anywhere from 500 - 2,000 words, 12 pt. font, Times New Roman, 1.5 spaced, and submitted as a Word document as outlined in the writer manual to pittpolreview@gmail.com.
